



## *INVER GROVE HEIGHTS DAYS*

### *PARADE GUIDELINES*

To provide an enjoyable and safe parade for everyone the committee has established the following guidelines for parade participants. We would appreciate your cooperation in observing these standards. Please copy and share this with your participant.

Adhering to these guidelines will help make a safe and enjoyable event for everyone.

1. **NO ITEMS TO BE THROWN FROM THE UNIT** (including water or candy). All items must be handed to the parade spectators. Also, all items must be suitable for a family audience.
2. **NO ALCOHOL.** Inver Grove Heights Days is a family event and no parade participants will be allowed to carry or have in their possession alcohol at any time before or during the parade.
3. All animal units are required to provide their own cleanup.
4. No changing of lineup positions will be allowed the day of the parade. The Inver Grove Heights Parade Committee will do its best to accommodate all requests for unit location prior to parade day, however there are many variables in mapping out the parade lineup. Any deviation can cause significant gaps for the viewing audience and the television broadcast.
5. Each unit entered must carry a general liability policy covering their unit with IGH Days named as additionally insured for that day.
6. Participant agrees to conduct themselves in an orderly manner in full compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Violators will be asked to leave.
7. To the extent permitted by law, parade participant hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Star City Days, Inc., Inver Grove Heights Days Committee it's members and agents, against any claims, losses or damages to persons, property, and costs. Arising out of, or connected with the event, including but not limited to, the set-up, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of parade route or a part thereof by participant.
